From the carpark , the world-wide largest tree top trail is accessible through the entrance tower. There, an integrated elevator allows senior citizens, handicapped people or parents with push chairs to enjoy an easy-going and comfortable visit, too. The 1300m-long path ends on the platform of the impressive 44m-high viewing tower.
